Big Green Egg Nest for Large EGG

The Big Green Egg Nest for the Large EGG is a heavy-duty powder-coated steel stand that raises the Large EGG to a comfortable cooking height while providing two locking caster wheels for mobility. Designed and manufactured in the USA exclusively for Big Green Egg, the Nest features a bracer bar for structural rigidity and is built to support the 162-pound Large EGG through years of regular outdoor cooking use. It is the original and most straightforward base option for the Large EGG, providing a stable, clean installation on any flat outdoor surface without the complexity of the Modular Nest System.

Heavy-Duty Powder-Coated Steel

The Large EGG Nest is fabricated from heavy-duty powder-coated steel. The powder-coat finish protects the steel from corrosion and weathering in outdoor conditions and provides a clean, consistent appearance. The steel gauge used in the Nest is appropriate for the sustained load of the 162-pound Large EGG at cooking height and for the dynamic loads applied when rolling the EGG on its casters. The bracer bar that runs across the base of the Nest frame adds torsional rigidity to prevent the stand from racking or twisting under load, which is a common failure mode in lighter-duty stands not designed for a ceramic kamado's weight.

Locking Casters

Two locking casters are included on the Large EGG Nest, allowing the EGG to be rolled to a new position on a flat patio or deck surface and then secured in place during cooking. The caster lock mechanisms prevent the EGG from rolling during high-heat sessions when unintended movement could be hazardous. The casters are sized to handle the 162-pound Large EGG's weight through repeated repositioning cycles without degrading in roll quality or locking reliability over time.

USA Design and Manufacturing

Big Green Egg Nests are designed and manufactured in the USA exclusively for Big Green Egg. This means the Nest is engineered to the specific dimensions and weight requirements of the Big Green Egg ceramic

components rather than being a generic stand adapted to fit. The dimensions of the Nest opening, the height of the stand, and the position of the casters are all specified to provide the correct cooking height and stability for the Large EGG specifically. The USA manufacturing origin reflects Big Green Egg's commitment to quality control and product specification for a component that supports a significant and valuable ceramic cooking appliance.

Compatible Accessories

The Large EGG Nest accepts optional Acacia Wood EGG Mates (sold separately) that can be mounted on the side rails of the Nest to provide prep surfaces adjacent to the EGG. For cooks who want integrated side work surfaces without the full footprint of a Modular Nest station, adding EGG Mates to the Large Nest creates a self-contained cooking station with meaningful prep space. The Nest Utility Rack (sold separately) can also be attached to the Nest to provide a hanging storage position for convEGGtors and cooking grids when not in use.
